- 1997:

- 2009:
 - Started being an activist



Malala Yousafzai

- 2012:
 - Taliban shot her in the head
 - Was taken to a hospital in the UK
- 2013:
 - Spoke at a meeting of the UNO
 - Published her book with a ghost writer

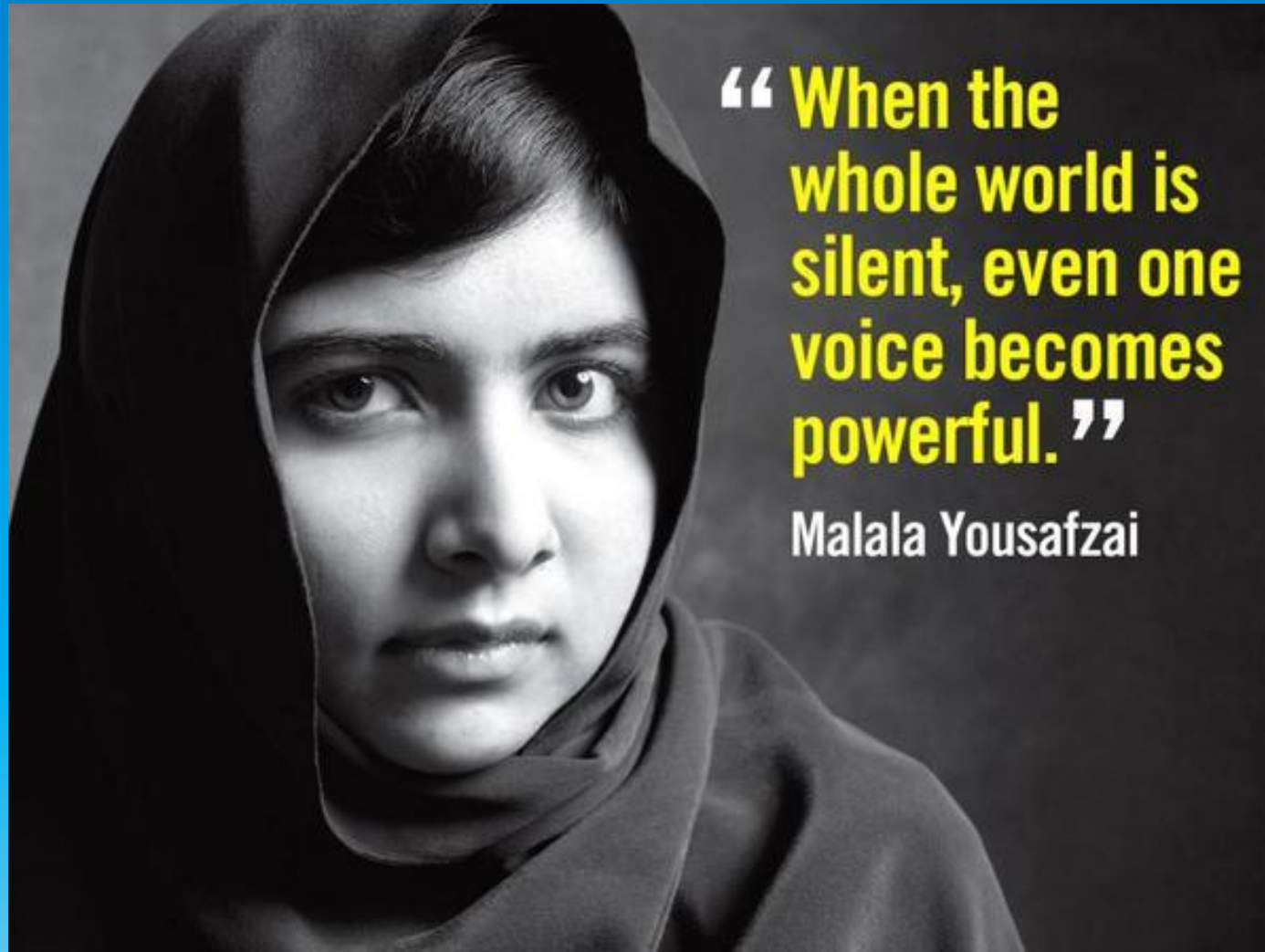
